College at a Glance:

This College is situated at Khyod, i.e. a place between Gohar and Chail Chowk, located by the side of Jiyuni Khadd (rivulet). The serene environment of GC Bassa (Gohar) persuades the seekers to quench their thirst of knowledge in the lap of the natural surroundings of this beautiful Gohar valley. The College is proud to complete 23 years of successful academic journey. The natives of Bassa are a witness to an awe-inspiring transformation of infrastructure of this College during this period. Students of the surrounding as well as the far flung areas of Seraj, Balh and Nachhan constituency are getting their education here in all the three faculties of Science, Arts and Commerce.

The vision and mission of our college is "To impart quality education, to inculcate values, develop overall personality and enhance the skills/potentials of the students as well as a sense of social responsibility.

Apart from infrastructural development, the College has made a remarkable growth in terms of academic, sports, cultural and other co-curricular activities. We have a firm faith that in upcoming times the College will touch new milestones of success and glory.

Availability of Various Faculties:

The highly qualified faculty and the entire infrastructure available in the college make it possible to offer students a high quality teaching-learning environment. The College offers various courses in the faculties of Humanities, Commerce and Science. The courses at undergraduate level were offered earlier under the CBCS semester system introduced by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla from the academic session 2013-14. The courses under the CBCS semester system underwent a change in the academic session 2016-17. From the academic session 2016-17 onwards, the courses at undergraduate level were offered under the new CBCS semester system introduced by UGC and adopted by HPU, Shimla. As per the guidelines of Himachal Pradesh Government and Himachal Pradesh University, a major change in new CBCS semester system has been brought by converting it in to an annual system from the academic session 2018-19 onwards. Under this system, the students can opt core courses, elective courses (Discipline specific courses, Generic elective courses and dissertation/projects) and Ability Enhancement Compulsory courses in Humanity, Science and Commerce.

Library: The College has semi-automated library with 4683 books, 10 magazines of different subjects, 5 daily newspapers and 2 weekly news papers have been subscribed for the benefit of the students. At present the post of Librarian is lying vacant. All the faculty members are provided access to National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (**N-LIST**) since 5th December, 2019 and it is renewed every year by our college. The faculty members and students can access the books and Research Journals of their interest. This institute also has an access to the **National Digital Library** Portal of Govt. of India. New library management software "Koha" has been installed in computer of library.

IT Lab: The College has two IT Labs, one each in Science and Arts Block. The IT Lab at Arts Block, with Dr. Vikram Singh, Asst. Prof. in Sociology, as its In-charge, has 7 computers and other related gadgets for the use of the students. With the help of RUSA Grant, IT Lab at Science Block has been facilitated with 25 computers. This Lab is being run under the supervision of Sh. Ramesh Kataria, Assoc. Prof. in Zoology and Dr. Surender Kumar, Asst. Prof. in Physics.

Smart Class Room: The Smart Class Room of the College has been built in Arts Block of the College. It has a capacity of 60 students. Presently various courses are being taught by the teachers with the help of Smart Class Room facility. A Photostat machine also has been installed in College Office for the benefit of the students. This classroom is under the supervision of Dr. Surender Kumar, Asst. Prof. in Physics and Dr. Shivendra Sangar.

Sanitary napkin vending machines along with the incinerators working and have been installed in ARTS and Science Block buildings of the College.

House Examinations:
